3. You must include your e-mail address as requested on the abstract submission form. All residents will receive confirmation by e-mail when the abstract is received.
4. Abstracts must conform and include: Title, Purpose, Methods, Results, Conclusions and Significance
5. All residents will be notified via e-mail by X date as to which abstracts have been selected for presentation.
6. Presentations are to be no longer than 10 minutes. All presentations must be given in PowerPoint format. There are no exceptions.
7. A short question and answer period concludes the presentations. The first place prize is \$100, 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$75 and third place \$50.
